Addendum #3 - Response to Questions

 Can you clarify the extent to which you would like the proposal "to develop methods to ensure all communities and abilities are engaged, including non-English speaking residents and mobility-impaired trail users"? For example, what languages other than English should materials and presentations be prepared in?

At minimum, we anticipate dedicated outreach to English and Spanish speakers. However, the consultant team may encounter the need to engage with additional languages and should be prepared to adapt accordingly.

2. What is the extent of the County/OSNR's existing relationships with communities and persons with differing abilities?

OSNR staff is active in the conservation and outdoor recreation communities in Eagle County. However, staff is looking to the consultant team to identify gaps in their existing relationships and provide guidance on building relationships with those who may be underrepresented.

3. Can you clarify the expected level of field-based or site-specific natural resources inventory?

It is important to staff that the members of the selected consultant team spend some time in the field becoming familiar with each of OSNR's properties. However, we are anticipating that the natural resource inventory will primarily be a desktop analysis of existing documents and GIS data. Some high level field verification may be needed, but no formal biological survey of OSNR properties is expected as part of this process.
