

Eagle County HHW Pricing Policy

<u>Electronics</u>: Certification Statement not required

- A. Seniors (age 65 and older) NO CHARGE
- B. Residents (of Eagle and other counties) 20 cents per pound flat rate
- C. Businesses (of Eagle and other counties) 20 cents per pound flat rate

<u>Chemicals and Paint:</u> **ONLY** accept chemicals from Eagle County residents and businesses

- A. Seniors (age 65 and older) NO CHARGE Certification Statement required
- B. Residents Certification Statement required
 - 1. 20 items or less two items can be 5 gallon containers NO CHARGE
 - 2. If resident has more than 20 items, weigh everything over 20 items and charge 20 cents per pound.
 - If resident has <u>only</u> 5 gallon containers (or larger), they can drop-off 28 gallons at NO CHARGE.
 Everything over 28 gallons will cost 20 cents per pound. Note: 28 gallons is equivalent to 2 X 5 gallon containers plus 18 X 1 gallon containers or 20 items.
- C. Businesses Eagle County CESQG Certification required
 - 1. Businesses must pay per pound pricing for everything NOTHING FREE
 - 2. Please refer to pricing table below:
