Potential Bidders on Rock Fall Mitigation Town of Red Cliff

RE: Addendum to the Request for Proposals for the Rock Fall Mitigation Town of Red Cliff

To Potential Bidders:

The RFP deadline for proposals has been changed from 5:00 p.m., MDT, February 1, 2019 to **5:00 p.m., MDT, May 1, 2019**.

The contract schedule has also been changed from starting no earlier than April 1, 2019 and completed by October 1, 2019. **The new contract schedule will be no earlier than May 1, 2019 and all work must be completed by October 31, 2020.**

Eagle County has received several questions regarding the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Rock Fall Mitigation Town of Red Cliff

- 1. Would roadway protection barriers be required?**
Yes, but jersey barrier can be supplied, installed and removed by the Eagle County Road and Bridge Department.
- 2. What will the traffic control requirements be, if not provided by the county?**
Traffic Control Plans have been provided in Addendum 1.
- 3. Will the county provide a dump site for spoils from the scaling process?**
The Eagle County Road and Bridge Department will remove spoils from the site.
- 4. Will the county provide any heavy equipment support for the removal of the scaled materials from the roadway?**
The Eagle County Road and Bridge Department will remove scaled materials from the site.
- 5. What is workday/workweek schedule? I.E. Monday through Friday 7AM to 5PM**
A proposed work schedule will have to be approved by the engineer, but is anticipated to be limited to Monday through Friday 7AM to 7PM. Any work outside of those hours will have to be approved by the engineer.

6. Will a public information agent be needed and or provided. Suggestions on firms in not provided

The Eagle County Engineering Department will perform all public information requirements.

7. If guardrails, signs, asphalt or other are damaged in the normal mitigation process, is the contractor responsible for replacement/repair?

Yes

8. What are the boundaries of rockfall mitigation work to be performed? How far up the road to Red Cliff, wrap around the corner

The limits of the work are anticipated to extend no more than 1,000 feet from the Highway 24 intersection. However, the scope of the project could expand over the duration of the project.

9. What utilities can we expect to find inside these boundaries

The only known utilities are the overhead power lines.

10. Are there buried utilities in this area?

None that are known to the county.

11. Will there be any replace/placement of guardrail expected by the contractor?

Any guardrail damaged by the contractor will have to be replaced at the contractor's expense. Jersey barrier can be supplied, installed and removed by the Eagle County Road and Bridge Department.

12. Is there an established budget for this project?

Not at this time.

13. Would Engineered/stamped drawings be required/requested?

Not at this time.
