



Elements of a Fire Safety Plan

To ensure a safe and successful event, if any activity involves fire, open flame, or fireworks, please consider the following items when planning the event:

- Consider where all emergency facilities, emergency access routes, hazards and fire extinguisher will be located.
- Consider all safety and/or egress lighting if the event takes place after dusk.
- Have exit routes for attendees been identified?
- A 'fire watch' may be necessary as determined by the local fire protection district having jurisdiction.
- Are fire restrictions in effect? Verify with the local fire protection district having jurisdiction.
- Fireworks may require additional permitting; please contact the local fire protection district having jurisdiction. A contact list will be provided to the applicant.
- Public law enforcement services may require compensation at a rate to be determined by the Eagle County Sheriff's Office. The Eagle County Sheriff's Office reserves the right to place Deputies at events as deemed necessary in the best interest of public safety. It is the responsibility of the event organizer to establish arrangements for law enforcement services well in advance of the special event.
