# EAGLE COUNTY CESQG REGISTRATION FORM

<b>WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM</b>	<p>Any person/group/business who attempts to derive a profit by any means, and in doing so generates or accumulates a hazardous waste;</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>AND</u></b></p> <p>who meets the criteria mentioned below:</p>
<b>QUALIFYING CRITERIA</b>	<p>Must be <u>located in</u> and <u>generate</u> the waste in <u>Eagle County</u>. Qualify as a CESQG as per 40 CFR Part 261.5. The criteria for a CESQG is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) One can produce/generate no more than 220 pounds/100 kgs or 27 gallons of hazardous waste in a month.</li><li>b) One can produce/generate no more than 1 kg/2.2 pounds or approx ¼ gallon of acute hazardous waste a month.</li><li>c) One can never accumulate more than 1000 kg/2,200 pounds or 220 gallons on-site at any time.</li></ul>
<b>SOME EXAMPLES..</b>	<p>Some examples (not all inclusive are): local government agencies, non profit groups, landlords, property managers, contractors, small businesses, auto repair shops, paint contractors, print shops, schools, hospitals, and metal fabricators.</p>



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<b>WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO TO START</b>	<p>Complete the enclosed waste certification form, waste identification form and waste inventory form.</p> <p>These forms are available at the facility and can be faxed to you upon request.</p> <p>Return the completed forms.</p> <p>This can be done in several ways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Drop it off at the HHW/CESQG facility.</li><li>b) Fax it to 970-328-3469</li><li>c) Send it in by interoffice mail to the landfill</li></ul>
<b>WHAT HAPPENS NEXT...</b>	<p>The HHW/CESQG staff will review the application and call you if they have any questions.</p> <p>The waste will be accepted for disposal or rejected. If the waste is rejected you will be informed of the decision behind the rejection. You will also be provided with a list of facilities that will accept the waste. If the waste is accepted, an account will be set up for your department. You will receive a reference number specific to your account.</p>
<b>MAKE AN APPOINTMENT</b>	<p>We will call you to make an appointment. We accept CESQG waste every <u>Friday</u> from <u>8 a.m. to 4 p.m.</u></p> <p>There is a mandatory \$10.00 registration fee for the entire calendar year.</p>



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<b>WHAT WILL IT COST &amp; HOW DO I PAY</b>	<p>The enclosed fee schedule will assist you in estimating the fee you will be charged for your waste.</p> <p>Payment is by cash, check or setting up a charge account.</p>
<b>WHAT CAN I BRING</b>	<p>Oil based Paint- paint related materials like thinners, varnishes, stains etc, Flammable and Combustible Liquids, Flammable Solid, Aerosol cans, Oxidizing Materials, Poison/Toxic Materials, Corrosive Materials like household cleaners, Motor Oil, Antifreeze, Batteries, Ammunition up to a 50 rounds caliber, Unknown Materials that <u>can be classified</u> after testing, Sharps, Mercury Thermostat and Bulbs, and Miscellaneous Materials like PCB Ballast, Latex Paint, Fluorescent Bulbs, Smoke Detectors etc.</p>
<b>WHAT CAN I NOT BRING</b>	<p>Explosives, Radioactive Materials, Shock Sensitive Wastes, Waste that <u>can't be characterized</u> by the HAZCAT testing system.</p> <p>Medical/ Biohazard Waste – this includes human blood, blood products, body fluids, specimens and wastes from labs, carcasses, body parts and bedding exposed to pathogens in research.</p> <p>(The only exception to this is Sharp's as mentioned above)</p> <p>Waste from CERCLA remediation sites.</p>



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<b>TRANSPORTATION OF WASTE</b>	<p>CDPHE Guidelines-“CESQG are exempt from having to obtain an EPA ID number and from using the hazardous waste manifest system, so they can transport their hazardous waste to treatment or disposal facilities using a common carrier under a standard bill of lading”.</p>
<b>HOW TO PACKAGE- 1</b>	<p>All materials must be packaged into sturdy, non leaking containers. If you have a leaking container place it in a larger container. Small leaking containers can be placed individually inside double zip lock bags. Include an original label or a note with as much information as possible about the material.</p>
<b>HOW TO PACKAGE-2</b>	<p>Don't mix different wastes in the same container. Place the materials upright in your vehicle; brace them so that they will not slide or tip over. Place materials in boxes in your vehicle trunk. We can't empty motor oil or gasoline cans while you wait for your container. Please indicate that you need your container back and please allow us 24 hours to return your container.</p>

GENERATOR INFORMATION:

Name and General Information- Name of the company and other contact information  
.e.g. phone number, mailing address, fax number, e-mail address

WASTE STREAM INFORMATION:

Name of Waste: Enter the name that is generally descriptive of the waste (e.g. paint sludge, contaminated soil, sharps)

Process Generating Waste: List the specific process/operation or source that generates the waste (e.g. painting, spill clean up, oil changes, auto body maintenance, etc.)

Amount Transported: Enter the amount of waste that will be generated and transported (expressed in pounds, gallons, or tons).

Frequency of Disposal: Enter how frequently this waste will be removed from the site.

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE WASTE:

Color: Describe the color of the waste- e.g. black, brown, muddy, transparent, varies etc

Odor: Do not smell the waste. If the waste has a known incidental odor check "YES" and describe it (e.g. acrid, pungent, solvent, and sweet)

pH: Check the appropriate box for the pH if it a liquid waste.

## EAGLE COUNTY CESQG CERTIFICATION

The Eagle county HHW and CESQG Program is limited to accepting only hazardous wastes exempted under the federal and state of Colorado regulations pertaining to CESQG exemptions. A general overview of the CESQG exemption regulation as follows: a) A generator must generate less than 100 kilograms (220 lbs or 25 gallons) of hazardous waste per calendar month or b) less than 1 kilogram (2.2 lbs or ¼ gallon) of acute hazardous waste per calendar month. c) A generator must never accumulate more than 1000 kilograms (2,200 lbs or 220 gallons) or 1 kilogram (2.2 lbs or ¼ gallons) of acute hazardous waste on site at one time.

By signing this certification, you are stating that you meet the above criteria and are eligible to participate in the Eagle County CESQG Program.
