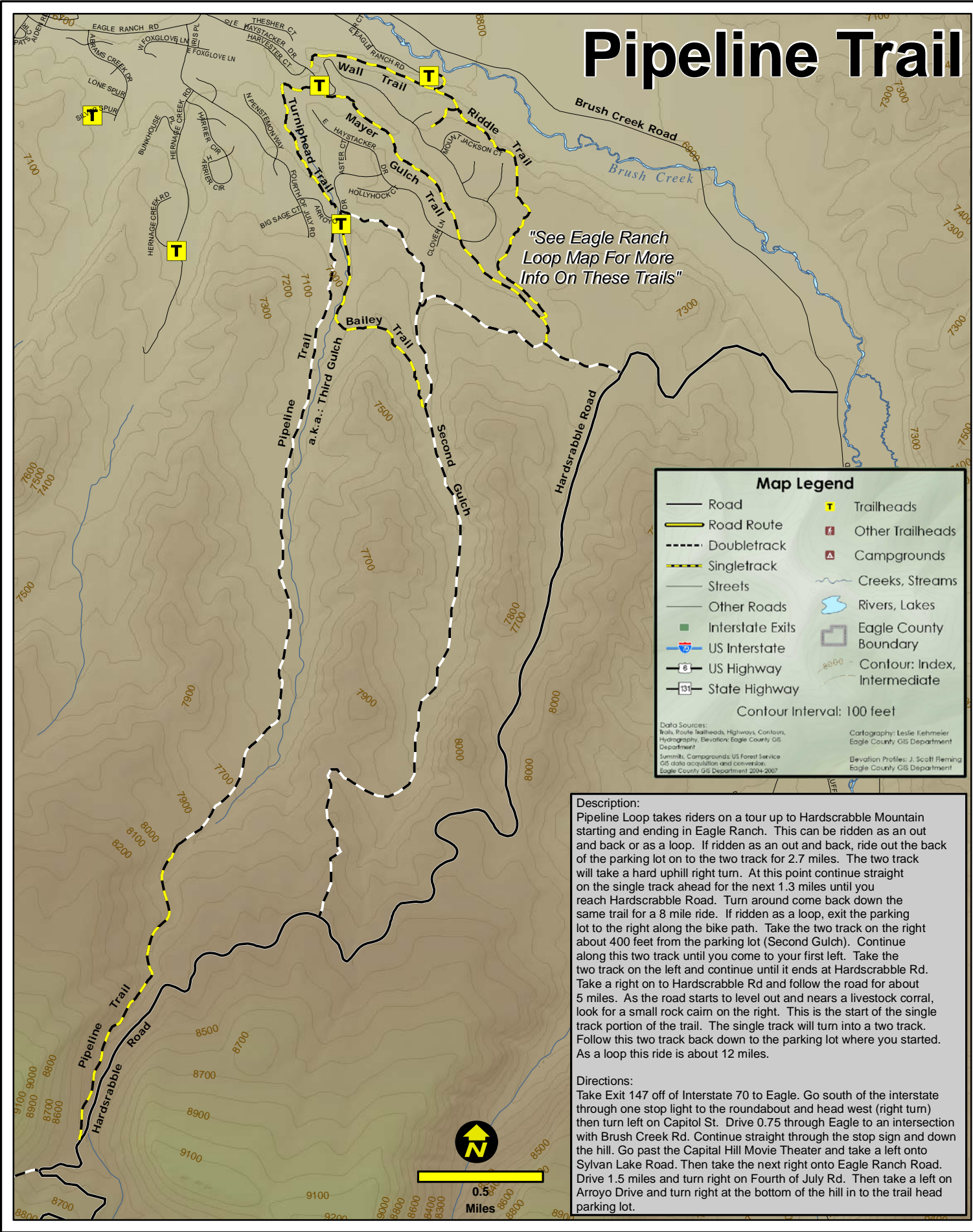


Pipeline Trail

Description:
 Pipeline Loop takes riders on a tour up to Hardscrabble Mountain starting and ending in Eagle Ranch. This can be ridden as an out and back or as a loop. If ridden as an out and back, ride out the back of the parking lot on to the two track for 2.7 miles. The two track will take a hard uphill right turn. At this point continue straight on the single track ahead for the next 1.3 miles until you reach Hardscrabble Road. Turn around come back down the same trail for a 8 mile ride. If ridden as a loop, exit the parking lot to the right along the bike path. Take the two track on the right about 400 feet from the parking lot (Second Gulch). Continue along this two track until you come to your first left. Take the two track on the left and continue until it ends at Hardscrabble Rd. Take a right on to Hardscrabble Rd and follow the road for about 5 miles. As the road starts to level out and nears a livestock corral, look for a small rock cairn on the right. This is the start of the single track portion of the trail. The single track will turn into a two track. Follow this two track back down to the parking lot where you started. As a loop this ride is about 12 miles.

Directions:
 Take Exit 147 off of Interstate 70 to Eagle. Go south of the interstate through one stop light to the roundabout and head west (right turn) then turn left on Capitol St. Drive 0.75 through Eagle to an intersection with Brush Creek Rd. Continue straight through the stop sign and down the hill. Go past the Capital Hill Movie Theater and take a left onto Sylvan Lake Road. Then take the next right onto Eagle Ranch Road. Drive 1.5 miles and turn right on Fourth of July Rd. Then take a left on Arroyo Drive and turn right at the bottom of the hill in to the trail head parking lot.
