

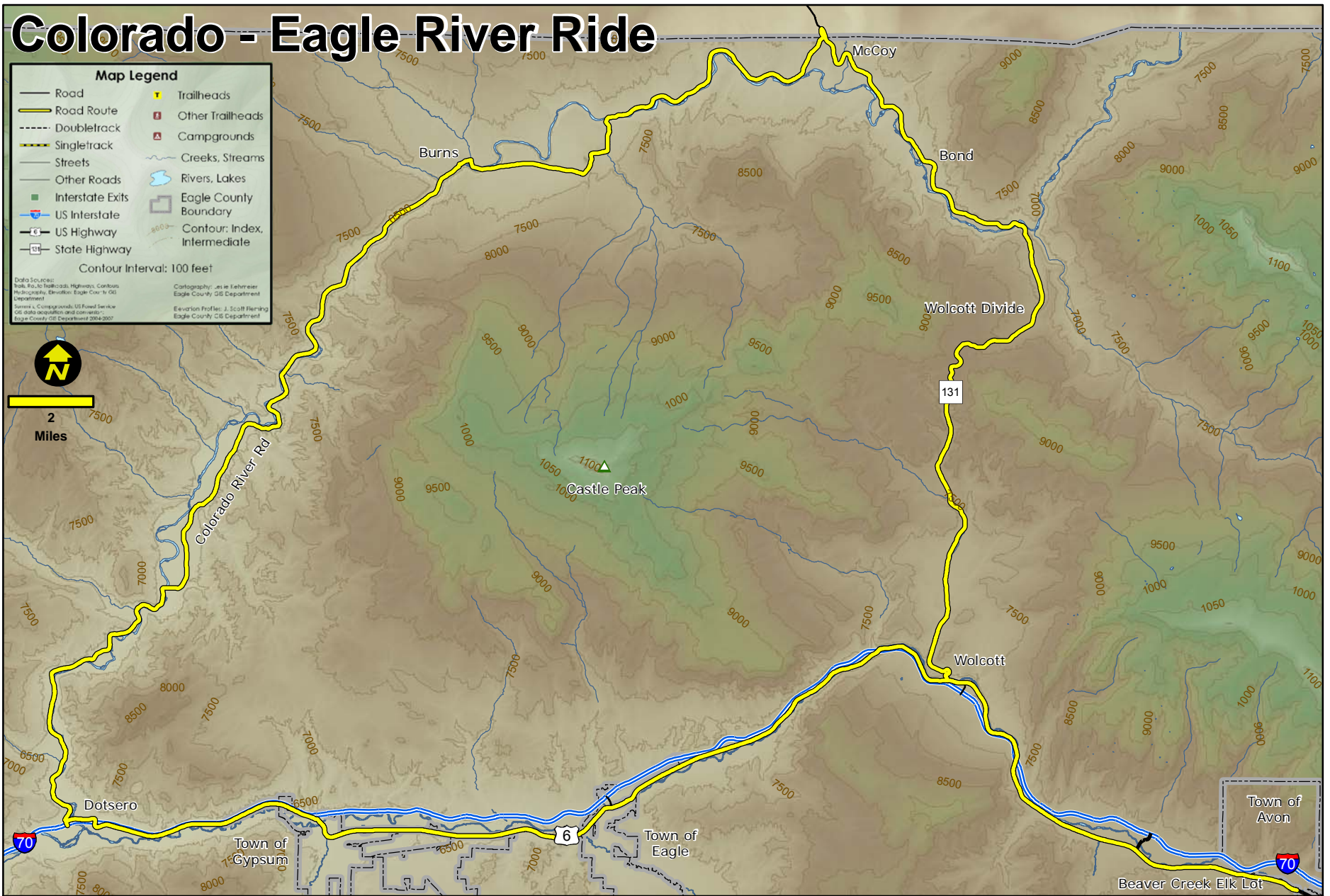
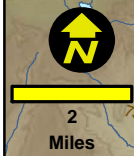
Colorado - Eagle River Ride

Teaser:
 The 100 mile Colorado – Eagle River Ride takes in all Colorado terrain, traveling along U.S. Highway 6 and Colorado State Highway 131 alongside the Eagle and Colorado rivers.

Description:
 The Colorado – Eagle River Ride starts from the Beaver Creek Elk parking lot. Head west along U.S. Highway 6 to Wolcott and turn right on Colorado State Highway 131. From here the ride has a few short climbs that take you to the top of the Wolcott Divide. From the divide there will be a fast descent into State Bridge. Continue on to McCoy and the left turn for Colorado River Rd. This is a hard pack dirt road that you will stay on until you get to Dotsero. At Dotsero turn left on to U.S. Highway 6 for the rest of the ride back to Beaver Creek Elk parking lot.

Directions:
 Take Interstate 70 to Exit 167, Avon. Turn south on Avon Road to U.S. Highway 6. Parking is available at the Beaver Creek Elk Parking Lot.
